The Director of Public Prosecutions has issued guidelines about when to prosecute people who assist a person to commit suicide **Please write to the Director of Public prosecution, Keir Starmer QC, 50 Ludgate Hill, London EC4M 7EX or Fax020 7710 3447** and tell him that you strongly disagree with the interim guidelines that he has issued for consultation until 16<sup>th</sup> Dec. Unless those categories are removed we risk undermining the existing protection of the law for the most vulnerable members of our society. The state has a duty to protect the lives of the most vulnerable of society. You have until the 16<sup>th</sup> Dec to disagree.
