The Solemnity of the Assumption this week on Thursday 15th August is a Holy Day of Obligation. This feast is recognised as early as 451 and given the title of the Assumption of the BVM from the eighth century. The uninterrupted tradition of the Church, witnessed by Gregory of Tours (549) and other Fathers of the church is the basis for the celebration of Mary's assumption into heaven, body and soul. The dogma of Mary's assumption was declared by Pope Pius X11 on 1st November 1950. There are three Masses at St. Anne's church for this Holy Day at 9.30am & 12.30pm and a Sung Mass at 7.30pm.
