Coronavirus: In response to the advice given by the Secretariat of the Catholic Bishops' Conference Bishop Marcus is introducing a number of pastoral measures effective from 10th March to 19th April 2020. Sign of Peace suspended; Receiving from the chalice shall cease; Holy water stoups emptied; Shared hymn books and Mass cards will not be used; the weekly bulletin is available but must be taken home after use and not put back in the stand. On Good Friday the Veneration will be a simple genuflection or bow of the head making the sign of the cross. Fr. Michael will speak about these measures before Holy Mass this weekend.
