Instructions about the Celebration of Holy Mass & the Sacraments

Saint Anne's Church is able to use 36 benches which follow the 2m social distance regulations. To enable parishioners to know they have a seat for Mass the Bishop has introduced a booking system which has now been installed on our parish website. (www.stanneskeighley.org.uk) Just press the button "Register for Mass" and book the tickets you want for a particular Mass. (2 people from same house book 1 ticket and a family of 4 book 2 tickets). For those who do not have the internet you can phone: 01535 645 454 on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday between 11.00am - 12 Noon and tickets will be booked for you. It is also fine to turn up to see if there are spare seats. The Government regulations stipulate that you will need to sign in. It is important to arrive in good time to sanitize your hands and then be shown to your seat by a Steward. Weekly Bulletin - please take home. Holy Communion will be administered with the priest standing behind the altar rails and Communion will be given in the hand. Communicants will return to their seats via the confessionals but Stewards will guide you. Singing is not allowed at present. Readers at Mass will come forward to the lectern but will need to collect gloves from the sacristy before Mass. If Bidding Prayers take place they will be read by the priest.

Confessions will be heard at the usual times on a Saturday or you can ask the priest after a weekday Mass. The kneeler will be taken out of the confessional and the penitent asked to stand for confession and then a Steward will sanitize the handles etc after each penitent leaves. Confessions will finish prompt at 6.00pm on Saturday to vacate seats for the Vigil Mass. **The Weekly Offertory Collection** will not be taken in the normal way but please leave your collection in the baskets either at the right side of the altar rails or at the side door as you leave church.
