The Good Shepherd Centre is accredited by the Office of the Immigration Services Commissioner and is able to provide FREE assistance in submitting settled status applications and to provide information and support. Keighley Catholic Centre: it has been necessary to carry out some repairs on the building as it has not been used for the past four months. When the builder checked the roof, he discovered that major work will need to be undertaken in the next year or so and this will also require scaffolding around the building. Fr. Michael has discussed this with the Diocesan property department and a full report will be required as the estimate is in excess of £20,000. When we can have a parish meeting it will be important, with all the facts before us, to decide what is the best course of action.
