A Saint of the Week

St. Maximillian Kolbe was born in Poland in 1894. He became a Franciscan in 1910. The invading German forces arrested him in 1939 and again in 1941 and he was sentenced to heavy labour at Auschwitz. On 31st July 1941, in reprisal for one prisoner's escape, ten men were chosen to die. Father Kolbe offered himself in place of a young husband and father. He was the last to die, enduring two weeks of starvation, thirst and neglect. He died on 14th August 1941 and was canonised by Pope John Paul 11 in 1981 which was attended by the young husband and father and his family that he saved. For all who suffer for truth and justice today we ask St. Maximillian Kolbe pray for them.

Instructions about the Celebration of Holy Mass from the Bishop

"Register for Mass" on the parish website or phone 645 454 Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday 11.00am - 12 Noon. For the Vigil Mass and all weekday Masses it is not necessary to book as there are plenty of seats available. The Weekly Offertory Collection will not be taken in the normal way but please leave your collection in the baskets either at the right side of the altar rails or at the side door as you leave church.

Face Coverings are mandatory from this Saturday 8th August. All those who are attending church must wear a face covering unless they are exempt. Priests in the sanctuary 2m or more from the congregation do not need to wear a face covering except when distributing Holy Communion. **Readers** may remove their face coverings at the lectern to read and should replace them before stepping away from it providing the lectern is 2m or more from the congregation.

Holy Communion: People should wait in their pews until instructed to move forward by the Stewards, always aware of the regulations on social distancing in the orderly queue. The communicant should unloop their face covering and with arms at "full stretch" extend their hands as flatly as possible, palms upwards, one on top of the other, to receive Holy Communion. They should then immediately consume the Sacred Host and replace their face covering before moving back to their seats following the one-way route.
