St. Anne's Restoration Work: a large section of the outside walls around the transept windows has been repointed

St. Anne's Restoration Work: a large section of the outside walls around the transept windows has been repointed during this last week. We also need work on the south transept windows because the pointing around the leaded lights is failing or missing and is falling to the ground inside the church. It is essential therefore to carefully repoint all the leaded light/stonework junctions to make the windows safe and control water ingress. We have applied for a grant towards this work and will hear in October if we have been successful therefore the work will not begin until the end of October and there will be scaffolding inside the church for a couple of weeks.

The Re-lighting of the Church is the final part of the church restoration and having received the faculty for this work from Historic Churches and permission from Diocesan Finance to spend the money we have raised for this project the electricians are coming to church on Monday 7th September to begin the work which should be completed before the end of September.
