Preparation for First Confession: The fourth lesson is on Monday 8th February from 6.30pm - 7.30pm. This year because of Covid-19 restrictions the celebration of Reconciliation on Saturday 6th March will begin at 10.00am and only four families will come at that time for the children to make their first confession. Then a further four at 10.15am and every 15 mins until all the children have made their confession. The names for each group have been given by Stephen at the Monday meeting. The certificates will be presented to the children on Sunday 7th March as they leave church at the end of Mass.

R.I.P. Marion Wright whose Requiem Mass is on Tuesday 9th February at 10.30am with Reception on Monday at 5.00pm. We offer our sympathy & prayers to all her family and friends at this time.

Ash Wednesday this year is 17th February and the Holy See has issued norms for the safe distribution of ashes during the pandemic this year. The priest says the prayer for blessing the ashes and sprinkles the ash with holy water in silence. Then he addresses all those present and only once says the formula from the Roman Missal, applying it to all in general: "*Repent, and believe in the Gospel*". The priest then sanitises his hands and wears a mask and at St. Anne's the people come to the altar rails, exactly the same as receiving Holy Communion. Then the priest takes the ash and sprinkles them on the head of each one without saying anything. This is in fact the ancient practice used for distributing the ash in Rome.

St. Anne's School are keeping Health Week beginning on Monday and as well as exercising and learning how to stay safe & healthy they will be raising money for Airedale Hospital & Community Charity by having a staff cycling challenge and the children we be running and walking in school and at home.
