Lent at St. Anne's Church: Ash Wednesday this year the priest addresses all those present and only once says the formula from the Roman Missal, applying it to all in general: "*Repent, and believe in the Gospel*". The people come to the altar rails and the ash is sprinkled on the head of each one in silence.

There are two Masses at St. Anne's with the Distribution of Ash at 12.30pm and a Sung Mass at 7.30pm

Stations of the Cross will take place on Tuesday before Mass and on Friday at 12 Noon. This year on Tuesday evening various communities representing the diversity of St. Anne's have been asked to lead the Stations in their own language. There will be a sheet available with the prayers for each Station in English.
