Message from the Bishop: Our baptismal faith calls us to put the needs of others before our own, nevertheless it would be unnatural if we did not, like others, have concerns about our own health and the wellbeing of our loved ones. At such a times, we can become very anxious and stressed, whether from feelings of helplessness or uncertainty. It is at those very moments that we need the spiritual gift of hope. The virtue of hope is critical for anyone who encounters suffering. This Lent may we be encouraged as we journey through Lent with the words of Benedict XVI from his encyclical "Saved by Hope".

"Redemption is offered to us in the sense that we have been given hope, trustworthy hope, by virtue of which we can face our present: the present, even if it is arduous, can be lived and accepted if it leads towards a goal, if we can be sure of this goal, and if this goal is great enough to justify the effort of the journey".
