Saint Patrick was born in 385 and at the age of 16 was kidnapped and sold into slavery in Ireland. He learned the Celtic language and was converted to the Catholic faith. Later he fled to France and was ordained to the priesthood and then returned to Ireland as a bishop and was very successful in proclaiming the Gospel. St. Patrick, who died in 461, is remembered for his simplicity, pastoral care and for his humble trust in God and for his fearless preaching of the Faith.
